Waukesha, Wisconsin— The Potawatomi Area Council, Boy Scouts of America cordially invites you to be a part of local Scouting history by attending the dedication and grand opening of the new Council Service Center. The new Council Service Center will service Scouting programs for future generations of youth. The dedication ceremony will take place on Thursday, September 25th at 5:15 pm at 804 Bluemound Road in Waukesha. Tours of the new facility will be offered from 3:30 until 5:00 pm.

The new Council Service Center replaces the old outdated and overcrowded 4,500 square foot facility which is now torn down. The grand opening will mark the first time ever that volunteers and staff will have an up to date service center geared toward the needs of membership in the Council's 77 year history. The building offers several meeting spaces, and a new National Scout Shop which supplies uniforms and other Scouting program gear.

The building of the new service center was made possible by many generous donors who will be formally recognized at the grand opening and dedication ceremony.
