

Crew 1881 First Responder Training

Learn the skills that could save a life!

This 44 hour training provides you with opportunity to learn skills in CPR, Bleeding Emergencies, Broken Bones, Shock, Spinal Injuries, and more. This course is certified by the U.S. Department of Transportation as an approved First Responder Curriculum. Upon successful completion of all skills and a score of 80% correct on a 100 question multiple choice exam, you will be awarded a 3 year Emergency Response certification and a 1 year CPR/AED-Adult, Child, Infant for the Professional Rescuer certification.

The class will meet Thursdays from December 11, 2008-April 9, 2009 (excluding the three weeks during Christmas and New Year's) from 6:30 PM-9:30 PM at the Waukesha Office of the American Red Cross at 2220 Silvernail Road, Pewaukee, WI 53072. Alternate work can be done for 1 or 2 conflicting dates.
